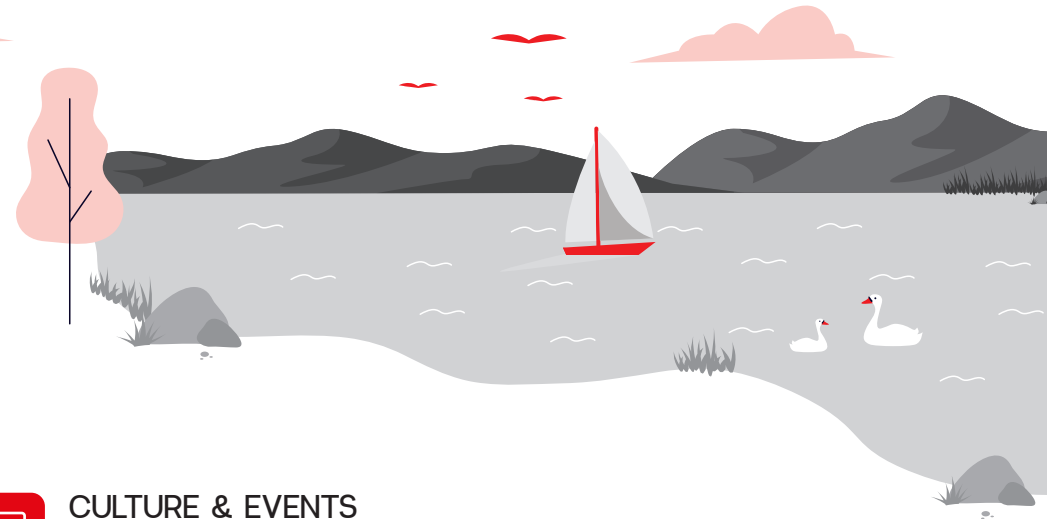

GASTRONOMY

- Guest registration (ends 23rd July)
- 3G rule (proof of test, vaccination or recovery)
- No mask requirement or restriction of group size
- No curfew, night time gastronomy open again



ACCOMMODATION

- Guest registration (ends 23rd July)
- 3G rule (proof of test, vaccination or recovery)
- No mask requirement
- Valid 3G proof required for the use of additional services at a hotel



LEISURE & SPORT

- Guest registration (indoors only, ends 23rd July)
- 3G rule indoors, for contact & team sports also outdoors
- No mask requirement



PUBLIC TRANSPORT & CABLE CARS

- Mask on buses, trains and cable cars, as well as in stations
- Standard face mask (cloth mask) sufficient
- No capacity restrictions in cable cars



CULTURE & EVENTS

- Guest registration (ends 23rd July)
- 3G rule (proof of test, vaccination or recovery) for culture
- Exception: no 3G proof required in museums or at events with less than 100 participants
- No curfew, no capacity restrictions
- No mask requirement, except in museums

HOW THE 3G RULE WORKS IN AUSTRIA

In line with the 3G rule, proof of a negative test, vaccination or recovery from a past infection is required from the age of 12 (Vienna: age of 6).

- **TEST:** PCR test valid 72 h, antigen test 48 h, monitored self-test 24 h (not valid in Vienna), on-site test for use of respective service (not available in Vienna)
- **VACCINATION:** valid from 22 days after first dose for max. 90 days and for 270 days after the second dose
- **RECOVERY:** valid for up to 180 days after the infection

GREEN PASSPORT/GREEN CERTIFICATE

The digital EU Covid certificate („green passport“) is recognized in Austria. Simply show your QR code – on your smartphone or printed. The certificate is not mandatory. Proof of vaccination, testing or recovery can also be provided via other recognized documents.
